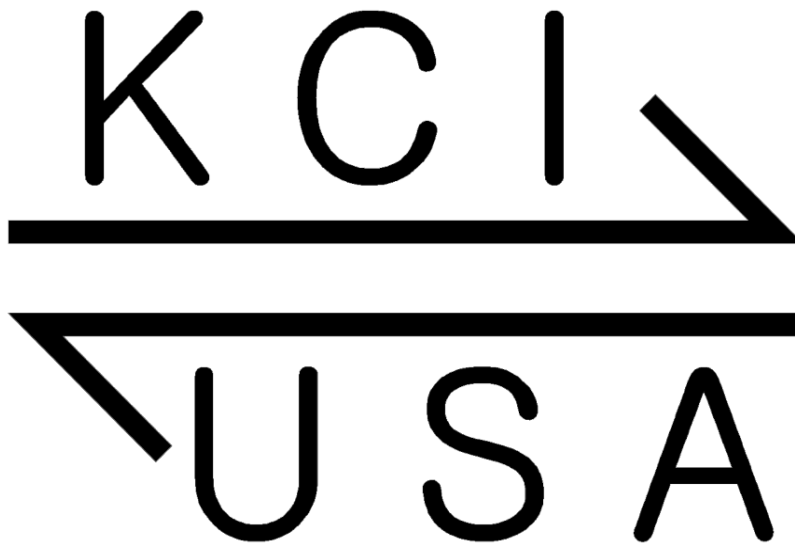

PREFACE-

Manufactured in Korea with the finest quality and the highest standard in mind, KCI has introduced the world's renowned AK-47 75RD DRUM ammunition magazine.

KCI USA, which has been in business for over a quarter century, has been designing & producing MAGs that exceed NATO SPEC. It is capable of being loaded with up to 75 rounds and it can be used repeatedly with a lifecycle of more than 50,000 rounds.

Our unique and high quality AK-47 75RD MAG will surely satisfy safe shooters who are looking for ultimate performance and fun.

OPERATION

**Please read and follow all instructions carefully*

Step 1:



Unlatch and open drum cover. Make sure the mainspring is not under tension and follower is up inside the tower.

STEP 2:



Depress center button to release spring tension. Rotate the feed wheel until the follower is positioned at approximately 2 o'clock direction.

CAUTION: The user must make sure the mainspring is not under tension when loading. Failure to do so may cause severe injury to contacting body parts.

STEP 3:

Load the first 3 rounds into outside snail track as shown. Rotate counter clockwise to push the first 3 rounds into the magazine tower.

STEP 4:

Applying pressure to the center button, rotate the feed wheel clockwise until the follower is at about the 11 o'clock position and rotation stops.

STEP 5:

Insert 1 round into the space shown for a total of 4 rounds in the tower.

STEP 6:

Load all remaining 71 rounds (any order) in the drum by filling the snail track in between the feed paws.

STEP 7:

Close the drum cover and lock the two latches. Wind the mainspring clockwise about 3 rotations.

WARNING: Do not over tighten the spring as this will cause wear or breaking to the main spring.

WARNING

The above procedure should only be used when loading magazine to its full capacity. If the user intends to load only a partial magazine, the magazine follower **MUST** be directly behind the last round. If there is a gap between the follower and the last round, the drum may be damaged during firing.

NOTICE

The drum magazine should always be stored with the main spring tension released. Open rear cover and depress the center button to make sure tension is released.



GENERAL SAFETY INFORMATION

NOTE: A firearm is capable of discharging when the magazine is removed. Always check the chamber to make sure that there is no cartridge left in the chamber. Never hand cycle live ammunition through a firearm. Firearm safety is the sole responsibility of the shooter. Always treat firearms as if they are loaded. Never point firearms at a person or pet, even if you think it is unloaded.

This instructional manual describes the proper use of the product and is for injury prevention. The user must read and follow this instruction. The warranties and liability established by KCI on the product will be voided if the product is not used in accordance with the instructions of the manual.
